Evelino Tile Adhesive C1 White – Type 1T (Non-Staining Glass Mosaic & Marble)

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Grey adhesive under a glass mosaic or a pale Italian marble tends to show through as a dull shadow or a dark edge — this is the white-cement version made to avoid that. It's the same C1-grade performance as our grey adhesive, just formulated with pure white cement so it doesn't discolour light or translucent tiles, and it holds tiles in place on vertical surfaces without slipping while it cures.

KEY FEATURES & PERFORMANCE ADVANTAGES

- Pure white cement — no grey shadow bleeding through translucent tile
- Meets IS 15477:2019 Type 1T and EN 12004 C1T
- Avoids the dark "picture-framing" edge that grey adhesive leaves under light tiles
- Anti-slip on walls, so tiles hold their position while setting
- Polymer-modified for good grip on smooth, large-format wall tiles
- Suited to glass mosaic, white marble, limestone and off-white ceramic

APPLICATION GUIDELINES & SITE PRECAUTIONS

SURFACE PREPARATION & MIXING

Substrate must be structurally sound, dry, flat, and free of laitance, oil, grease, or loose debris. Mix thoroughly according to product technical directions. Use clean tools and potable water or hardener as specified.

STORAGE & ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS

Apply in ambient temperatures between +5°C and +35°C. Avoid direct harsh sunlight and rain during application and initial cure. Store in original sealed containers in a cool, dry place off concrete floors.

HEALTH & OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY

Wear suitable protective gloves, safety goggles, and respiratory masks during mixing and application. In case of contact with eyes or skin, wash immediately with plenty of clean water and seek medical advice.
