Evelino Tile Adhesive C2 Plus White Type 3 (High-Strength White Exterior Facade)

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The white-cement version of our C2 Plus Type 3 facade adhesive, for the same demanding exterior applications — heavy natural stone, large-format porcelain, high-rise cladding — but where a grey adhesive would risk staining through light or white stone. It carries the same S1 deformability and extended open time as the grey version, so it handles thermal movement and gives you time to position large panels correctly.

- Meets IS 15477:2019 Type 3 and EN 12004 C2TE S1
- S1 deformability absorbs thermal expansion without bond failure
- Non-sag vertical grip holds heavy slabs on facades
- White copolymer resin base prevents grey staining under light stone
- Extended open time (30+ minutes) for positioning large stone panels
- Stable across monsoon humidity and freeze-thaw cycling

APPLICATION GUIDELINES & SITE PRECAUTIONS

SURFACE PREPARATION & MIXING

Substrate must be structurally sound, dry, flat, and free of laitance, oil, grease, or loose debris. Mix thoroughly according to product technical directions. Use clean tools and potable water or hardener as specified.

STORAGE & ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS

Apply in ambient temperatures between +5°C and +35°C. Avoid direct harsh sunlight and rain during application and initial cure. Store in original sealed containers in a cool, dry place off concrete floors.

HEALTH & OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY

Wear suitable protective gloves, safety goggles, and respiratory masks during mixing and application. In case of contact with eyes or skin, wash immediately with plenty of clean water and seek medical advice.
